Dog licenses—State law mandates that **ALL DOGS** be licensed. Please submit a valid rabies vaccination certificate in order to be issued tags for your dog. The form is on the website. Fees are \$10 for spayed/neutered dogs and \$15 for intact dogs. Licenses expire on 3/31/2024. Those individuals will be responsible to pay fees of \$169 per dog if not licensed if they fail to comply within 30 days of notice from the District Attorney's office, State Statute 174.12(4)

THINK SPRING AND MEMORIAL TREES—There are a few trees at the south pond that are not claimed as memorial trees. The trees did well over the past year and are growing! If you wish to have a tree reserved for a memory of anyone, the cost is \$100 per tree which includes the tree and an engraved plaque. Contact the village office at the above number to reserve your tree! A great gift for that hard to buy person—the person being honored does not have to be deceased! Mark a tree in honor of your family or friends with your favorite sentiment on the plaque! A great fun idea borrowed from a resident—, plant a tree for your children/grandchildren and watch it grow as your family grow!!

SNOW—Well, we didn't get much and happy to report that the village budget for snowplowing didn't take a hard hit! The no parking rules from midnight til 7 am is still in effect until April 1 however. Please cooperate by keeping your vehicles off of the street between these hours. Everybody wants the streets to be clear early in the morning and the DPW employees start clearing very early in the morning even before we are awake so that the streets can be clear for you to get to work, appointments, or school!
