Water Utility Rate Increase--not good news, but necessary.

The village must supply the residents with water and sewer service. The water utility has been ending the past years with a negative balance, meaning the expenses are exceeding the income. It is necessary to have an 8% rate hike increase. Enclosed is the required notice to the public, and it is also being published in the Nov. 2 issue of the Star News. The rate increase is intended to take effect with the 1/4/2024 meter reading so that there are not pro-rated bills. If you wish to see the detailed profit and loss statements for the water utility, please contact this office.

Memorial Trees—There are a few trees at the south pond that are not claimed as memorial trees. The trees did well over the summer and are growing! If you wish to have a tree reserved for a memory of anyone, the cost is \$100 per tree which includes the tree and an engraved plaque. SNOW—Say it isn't so—just a reminder that Ordinance #247 prohibits parking on any public street November 1 to April 1 between the hours of midnight and 7:00 am to allow for removal of snow. **Please cooperate by keeping your vehicles off of the street between these hours.** Everybody wants the streets to be clear early in the morning and the DPW employees start clearing very early in the morning even before we are awake so that the streets can be clear for you to get to work, appointments, or school!

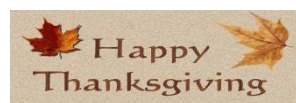
