—just a reminder that Ordinance #247 prohibits parking on any public street November 1 to April 1 between the hours of midnight and 7:00 am to allow for removal of snow. Please cooperate by keeping your vehicles off of the street between these hours. Everybody wants the streets to be clear early in the morning and the DPW employees start clearing very early in the morning, even before we are awake so that the streets can be clear for you to get to work, appointments, or school!

**Budget hearing and adoption will be held on Monday, November 10, 2026** at 4pm with regular board meeting to follow.

Caucus will be held on Monday, January 12, 2026 at 4 pm before the regular village board meeting. Board members' terms who expire this spring are Tyler Lemke and Will McCarron. Terms are for two years-Spring election is 4/7/2026.

Compost Site- The village yard waste collection site is east of the Water Tower. No large tree branches, no plastic pots/bags, no garbage!! Materials allowed are grass, leaves, small twigs and branches less than 4", and garden waste. THIS IS FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS ONLY-THERE HAS BEEN PEOPLE FROM OUT OF THE VILLAGE LIMITS BRINGING ITEMS IN!!

Meals on Wheels—meals are served on Tues/Thurs at 11:30 am at the Centennial Hall for eligible participants. Contact the Commission of Aging Office at 715-748-1491. Home delivery is also available—those delivered meals receive the daily meal plus a meal for the next day. The Commission on Aging Office has much to offer to our seniors, not just meals, but support, education, transportation, and entertainment, just to name a few items.

Regular board meeting for December will be held one week later- Monday, Dec. 15, 2025 at 4 pm due to board member schedule conflicts. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend! If you wish to speak at a meeting, please contact the clerk five days prior to meeting to be placed on the agenda.

**Regionalization Project**—The Village of Stetsonville is working in cooperation with the City of Medford to pipe the village's wastewater to the city's treatment plant. The project is scheduled to take around two years to complete.

Overdue Utility Bills—Overdue Notices were sent out October 21, 2025. If you received one of these notices, please pay immediately. All Overdue accounts will be placed on tax roll with an extra 10% service charge added.
