—just a reminder that Ordinance #247 prohibits parking on
any public street November 1 to April 1 between the hours of
midnight and 7:00 am to allow for removal of snow. Please
cooperate by keeping your vehicles off of the street between
these hours. Everybody wants the streets to be clear early in
the morning and the DPW employees start clearing very early
in the morning, even before we are awake so that the streets
can be clear for you to get to work, appointments, or school!

added.**
