Chicken Permits- the village ordinance #250 allows for four hens to be kept according to the rules set forth in the ordinance. A complete copy of the rules can be seen on the village website. Those permits are valid from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31, and must be renewed annually if you are a chicken keeper!

The second half is due to the county treasurer by 7/31/2025.

Please drop in box outside or in the hallway, or mail/email them to the office. If you have concerns, please contact a member of the board.

Recycle and Trash site is open Wednesdays from 5 pm to 7 pm and Saturdays from 9 am to 1 pm. A 30 gallon/ regular kitchen bag is \$3 and an over 30 gallon bag and barrel is \$5. *Please have small bills/exact change when paying for the disposal of your trash.* As always, recyclables are free to dispose of. The site is at the shop, by the water tower, on the southeast corner of the village. If you wish curbside service, then you must contract it independently.

Compost Site-Christmas trees are accepted at the compost site. The village does not offer curbside collection.
