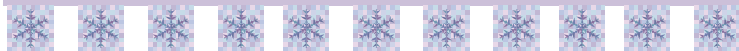

SNOW—Say it isn't so—just a reminder that Ordinance #247 prohibits parking on any public street November 1 to April 1 between the hours of midnight and 7:00 am to allow for removal of snow. **Please cooperate by keeping your vehicles off of the street between these hours.** Everybody wants the streets to be clear early in the morning and the DPW employees start clearing very early in the morning even before we are awake so that the streets can be clear for you to get to work, appointments, or school! So far, the snow totals have been next to nothing, which is saving on expenses for snow removal again this year. Mother Nature might have a surprise up her sleeve though, so be aware!

DOG LICENSES expire 3/31/2025. A valid certificate of rabies vaccination is required to issue tags for your dog(s). Failure to license Rover can result in a \$169 fine.

Chicken permits (up to four hens) are required annually as well at a cost of \$15. Form is available on web site.

REMEMBER IF YOU SEE SOMETHING HAPPENING IN VILLAGE REQUIRING THE SHERIFF'S DEPT- CALL THE TAYLOR COUNTY SHERIFF DEPT. THE VILLAGE HAS NO CONTROL OVER SPEEDING, FIREWORKS, DOGS RUNNING LOOSE, SPEEDING ETC. These are state laws!

Meals on Wheels/Nutrition Site—meals are served on Tues/Thurs at 11:30 am at the Centennial Hall for eligible participants. Contact the Commission of Aging Office at 715-748-1491. Cost is \$5 per meal. Home delivery is also available to those who qualify—those delivered meals receive the daily meal plus a meal for the next day.
