Chicken Permits- the village ordinance #250 allows for four hens to be kept according to the rules set forth in the ordinance. A complete copy of the rules can be seen on the village website. Those permits are valid from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31, and must be renewed annually if you are a chicken keeper!

ALL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE COMPLAINTS MUST BE IN WRITING, and will only be considered if it is submitted.

The form is available on the website or at the village office. Please drop in box outside or in the hallway, or mail/email them to the office. If you have concerns, please contact a member of the board. Now that the snow is gone, PLEASE tidy up your yard and buildings!

Recycle and Trash site is open Wednesdays from 5 pm to 7 pm and Saturdays from 9 am to 1 pm.

A 30 gallon/regular kitchen bag is \$3 and an over 30 gallon bag or barrel is \$5. Please have small bills/exact change when paying for the disposal of your trash. The site is at the shop, by the water tower, on the southeast corner of the village. If you wish curbside service, then you must contract it independently. It really is a bargain to use the village's garbage program!!! And remember recyclables are free to dispose of!
