PROPERTY MAINTENANCE ORDINANCE

Residents, please remember that the village has a property maintenance ordinance. This includes keeping your grass mowed, weeds trimmed, and keeping garbage, including discarded items such as furniture, appliances, and cars out of sight and not laying around on your property. We all wish to live in a nice community that we can be proud of to call “home”. Please do your part by keeping your property tidy. Warning letters have been sent to many properties in the village and the offenders will be soon fined if they don’t clean up their property. **This is the number one complaint to this office is unkempt properties!!! NO MOW MAY IS OVER-please keep your lawn trimmed!**

CAMPFIRES are allowed in designated pits—**BURNING TRASH IN THE VILLAGE IS NOT ALLOWED!**

RECYCLE CENTER- and trash is accepted at the village garage site on Wednesdays from 5 pm to 7 pm and Saturdays from 9 am to 1 pm. There is no curbside service in the village; the question has been asked a few times and residents have voiced their opinion that they wish the center to be the way to dispose of trash. If you wish to have curbside service, it is to be contracted on your own through one of the haulers. You may still bring your recyclables to the shop for no charge.

Accepted are:

- Branches and twigs
- Tree trunks and branches less than 4" in diameter
- Grass clippings
- Leaves and garden/flowerbed waste

NOT Accepted:

- Tree trunk and branches greater than 4" in diameter
- Plastic bags and flower pots
- Rubbish
- Rubber products
- Metal
