RECYCLE CENTER- and trash is accepted at the village garage site on Wednesdays from 5 pm to 7 pm and Saturdays from 9 am to 1 pm. There is no curbside service in the village; the question has been asked a few times and residents have voiced their opinion that they wish the center to be the way to dispose of trash. If you wish to have curbside service, it is to be contracted on your own through one of the haulers. You may still bring your recyclables to the shop for no charge.

Compost Site- remember that only twigs, branches less than 4", grass clippings and garden waste is allowed at the compost site. Please respect the rules of the site.
