BOARD MEETING - Monday, July 13, 2026 at 4:00pm at the JMTM Library. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend! If you wish to speak at public comment time or on an agenda item, you must call the Village Office at least 5 days prior to the meeting to be placed on the agenda. Agendas are posted on the website and at the Village Hall, shop, and post office.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE - Please remember that the Village has a property maintenance ordinance to keep our community beautiful and safe. Keep your grass mowed, weeds trimmed, garbage in cans, debris- to include furniture, appliances, cars and trash- out of sight and not laying around your property. Property maintenance is the biggest complaint in our community so please do your part to keep your property neat and our Village beautiful.

PLEASE DO NOT BLOW YOUR GRASS CLIPPINGS INTO THE STREET. THE CLIPPINGS PLUG UP CULVERTS AND DITCHES, NOT TO MENTION OUR SEWER SYSTEM.

BUILDING PERMITS - Building permits are **REQUIRED** for ANY projects over \$2500. Please see the Village Website for the form and fee schedule. Return completed forms with payment to the clerk's office **BEFORE** you start your project.

COMPOST SITE - Remember that the compost site accepts brush less than 4", twigs, garden waste, and leaves. **DO NOT** bring any garbage, plastics, metal, rubber, logs over 4" or anything that isn't organic. Please pay attention to the signs on where items should be unloaded.

TIRE COLLECTION - The Recycling Authority will collect old tires at The Medford Highway Department on Saturday, August 8th. See attached flier for details.

RECYCLE!!! - The Recycle Site is located by the water tower on East Mink Ave and is open on Wednesdays from 5:00pm to 7:00pm and Saturdays from 9:00am to 1:00pm. All recyclables are **FREE!** The success of our community recycling program depends on resident participation. The more residents use and support the recycling program, the stronger the program becomes and the greater the opportunity for the Village to receive continued funding and support for recycling services. Increased participation helps demonstrate the value of the program and can assist the Village in maintaining and improving recycling operations for the future.

BURNING TRASH IN THE VILLAGE IS NOT ALLOWED!

VILLAGE POLICY CHANGE ON OVERDUE UTILITY BILLS - Beginning **January 1, 2027**, the Village will implement an updated utility billing policy regarding overdue balances. Utility accounts with a past-due balance exceeding \$10.00 will be subject to late fees and may have services disconnected until the account is brought current. This advance notice is being provided to give residents ample time to bring any existing overdue balances current before the new policy takes effect. Residents are encouraged to make payments by the due date to avoid penalties or interruption of services.
