BOARD MEETING - Monday, March 9, 2026 at 4:00pm at the JMTM Library. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend! If you wish to speak at public comment time or on an agenda item, you must call the Village office at least 5 days prior to the meeting to be placed on the agenda. Agendas are posted on the website and at the Village Hall, shop, and post office.

PLOWING - Just a reminder that Ordinance #247 prohibits parking on any public street from November 1st to April 1st between the hours of midnight and 7:00am to allow for the removal of snow. **Please cooperate by keeping your vehicles off of the streets between these hours.**

DOG LICENSES EXPIRE 3/31/2026 -

State law mandates that ALL DOGS be licensed. The application is available on the Village website or at the Village Hall. A valid certificate of rabies vaccination is required to issue tags for your dog(s). Failure to license can result in a \$169 fine.

CHICKEN PERMITS - Chicken permits are valid from January 1st through December 31st and must be renewed annually. The cost is \$15. Rules and applications are available on the Village website.



PROPERTY TAXES - Tax payments are no longer accepted locally. Remember that your second payment is due to the Taylor County Treasurer by 7/31/2026.

DAYLIGHT SAVINGS - Daylight Savings Time begins March 8, 2026. Remember to set your clocks ahead!



MEALS ON WHEELS/NUTRITION SITE - Meals are served on Tuesday and Thursday at 11:30am at the Centennial Hall for eligible participants. Contact the Commission of Aging Office at 715-748-1491. Cost is \$5 per meal. Home delivery is also available to those who qualify. Those who receive delivered meals receive the daily meal plus a meal for the next day. The ARDC Office has much to offer to our seniors, not just meals, but support, education, transportation, and entertainment, just to name a few items.

ELECTIONS - The Spring General Election is Tuesday, April 7, 2026 from 7:00am to 8:00pm. Please go to **My Vote Wisconsin** to pre-register or apply for absentee ballots. **You need to re-apply each year for absentee ballots.** Board members who will be on the ballot are Will McCarron and Tyler Lemke.

BUILDING PERMITS - The season of improvements is approaching fast! Remember that building permits are required for ANY projects over \$2500.
