**HAPPY HOLIDAYS!** The end of 2023 will be here before you know it. I have gotten positive comments from residents appreciating the newsletter and the information that is included in them, so I will continue them! If you have any suggestions/contributions, please share with me.

VILLAGE HALL—Clerk/treasurer office hours are Mon. Tues., Thurs. 7:30 am to 2:00 pm.; Wed. 7:30 am to 11:30 am If I happen to be out of the office, I am generally out on an errand which includes the bank, post office and trips to the shop. There is a white drop box on the north side of the building to deposit your utility bills, tax payments, and other correspondence in. If you wish a receipt, please indicate that on the payment. Remember this is a "one person" office.

**Shop Hours:** The DPW employees work Mon-Thurs. from 6 am to 3:30 pm and Friday morning. They are always on call for an emergency if necessary.

REAL ESTATE TAXES—tentatively, tax bills will be ready to be mailed after the week of December 11. 1<sup>st</sup> payments are due locally by January 31, 2024 (anything in mail or courier box on Tuesday, 1/2/2024 morning will be receipted as of 12/31/2023) and the 2<sup>nd</sup> payment is due by July 31, 2024 to the county treasurer. Again, please mail in your payments or use the drop box. If you wish a receipt, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope to receive a receipt or include your email address to receive a receipt.

**REMINDER –NO PARKING** (ord. # 247) is allowed on the streets in the village from midnight to 7 am from Nov 1st to April 1<sup>st</sup>. A forfeiture of \$25 per offense if paid within five days; otherwise a citation with a court date and further costs will be issued. This allows for snow removal! Your full cooperation is appreciated!

**CAUCUS**- A caucus will be held on 1/8/2024at 4 pm prior to the regular village board meeting to nominate candidates for the ballot. The village has a five-person board, with alternate year elections. Village president and two village board seats will be nominated.
