REMINDER – The village has a property maintenance ordinance that's purpose is to protect public health, safety, and welfare by establishing "minimum" property standards. We all wish to live in a neat and tidy community, so please do your part in keeping your property maintained! This includes cutting of long grass, trimming of weeds, and keeping your property free of litter, rubbish, unwanted furniture or appliances, unlicensed vehicles, or other debris. Penalties will be imposed for those who have been warned to clean up their property and refuse to do that.

There have been numerous complaints to this office about dogs and other issues between neighbors---there are no extra village ordinances that I am aware of—the state statute chapter 174 governs all rules regarding dogs including leash law, controlling your dog, injury to others, etc. Please be a good neighbor! Again-if you have an issue, call the Taylor Co. Sheriff's office and file a complaint; or the Taylor Co. Humane Society if you believe an animal is being mistreated.

Compost Site-THE LEAVES WILL SOON BE FALLING OFF THE TREES. The village yard and garden waste collection site is east of the Water Tower. Please pay attention to the rules—no large tree branches/logs, no plastic pots/bags, no garbage!! Materials allowed are grass, leaves, small twigs and

branches diameter less than 4", and garden waste.
